

## **\*\*New Therapeutic Art and Artistic Training\*\***

The Sienna Academy training began in 2008 and has now completed 2 full rounds of training. It is taught in accordance with the method and insights of Liane Collot d'Herbois, based on the colour research of Goethe and Rudolf Steiner. Students come from far and wide: Thailand, Japan, China, India, New Zealand and many distant parts of Australia. The training has been newly formed into a shorter 'post graduate' style training which will take 2.5 to 3 years to complete. Visiting students are always welcome.



It is taught in 2 blocks of 4 weeks a year; each block is made up of two x 2 week modules. Overall, there are 14 modules to complete, with a different colour focus each time.

Medical lectures and other specialist subjects form an integral part of the training; students may access these in their own locality,

The Training is accredited by the European Academy for Anthroposophic Art Therapies (EA), which is an evaluation and quality assurance body of the Medical Section at the Goetheanum, Dornach, Switzerland.

### **All modules address 3 aspects:**

- 1) Training the artistic abilities of the student
- 2) Training the individual student's development as a painting therapist
- 3) Training the therapist/ client working relationship
